Specific Policies	Instructor to carry 1st aid kit Participants to be fitted with harness and helmet when traversing Instructor to wear a helmet and keep hazard area clear during tensioning phase System diagram to be carried and used to check setup prior to participant use Spotters stationed at entry and exit points to aid slider Instructor to attach slider Ratio: 12 participants: 1 Instructor and 1 Adult Helper (AH) (Note: AH is considered as part of the ratio)
Emergency Response	Seeking Assistance: Adult can be sent to the onsite office, or personal mobile phones used Follow general YMCA Emergency Procedures Follow relevant site evacuation procedures
Previous Incidents	Equipment malfunction (human error); slips/trips on entry/exit points; finger/hair entrapment; fracture caused by equipment failure

Site/Activity Specific Hazard/Risk	Management of Hazard
Anchor failure	Instructor to visually check anchors (trees/poles) are sound and sturdy. System diagram to be carried as part of activity equipment and checked before system use. Knots and connections points must be as described by the system diagram, and checked by instructor before use. Hazard area to be kept clear during tensioning phase.
Rocks	Brief participants on moving around site. Closed toe shoes.
Injury from falling	Instructor to inspect Tyrolean set-up prior to use by group. Harnesses and helmets correctly fitted. Instructor to supervise attachment to traverse. Back-up strop connected to the slider from karabiner connected to the pulley
Entanglement in rope	Instructor to brief and manage
Rope burn	Instructor to brief and manage. Ensure active communication between groups on each side of traverse
Entanglement in pulleys	Long hair to be tied back and loose clothing to be corrected. Brief participants to keep appendages clear of pulley
