Injury from arrow (shot/static)	Management and group control, clear explanation and demonstration of the range safety rules; vigilance of shooting, retrieving and carrying of arrows by Instructor; make use of the retiring line and waiting safe area				
Forearm injury from bow string	Participants to wear long sleeved clothing. Participants to be coached in correct technique.				
Arrow rebounds	Ensure correct firing technique, posture and positioning.				
Site Specific – Kimihia Camp Site	Ensure other user groups know that the range is in use.
