

## TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS

Please see below for information regarding transportation of participants while at camp. We have plastic tarps available to put in your cars to help keep your seats clean and dry.

Paddling	<ul> <li>Emergency vehicle required.</li> <li>Wainui Park will supply a van which can seat 8 participants.</li> <li>Group or school supplied vehicle to follow behind to Tikao Bay (4.8km) with overflow participants</li> </ul>
Coasteering	<ul> <li>Group or school supplied vehicle to ferry all students and instructors to Cape Three Point (2.5km).</li> </ul>
Raft Building	<ul> <li>Emergency vehicle required.</li> <li>Participants to walk down to Wainui Community Hall (1km)</li> <li>Emergency vehicle to drive down with helmets and PFDs and park outside Wainui Community Hall</li> </ul>
Snorkelling	<ul> <li>Emergency vehicle required.</li> <li>Although this is not a requirement, we suggest a group/school supplied vehicle to ferry participants to the beach (1.6km) to ensure maximum time in the water.</li> </ul>
Scenery Nook	— Transport to Scenery Nook of participants and instructors (10.7km)
Tramp to Camp	<ul> <li>If you complete Tramp to Camp- we will help shuttle you back to any vehicles.</li> <li>If completing Tramp to Camp as part of a program – Transportation of students to Tikao Quarry (4.6km) is required.</li> </ul>

## DRIVERS, PLEASE NOTE:

- Some of the roads around Wainui are narrow and windy please ensure to drive to conditions and speed limit
- Cars are NOT to be driven up the driveway to our gear shed and camp office. Students will walk back to vehicles parked by High Ropes or the East Carpark. This is not negotiable, please do not be offended if you do this and we ask you to move. This is part of our health and safety procedures to reduce risk in one our main areas working with the participants.
- Coasteering Parking is tight. At times, the general public may use the same parking. Our instructors will direct you to the best alternative location

If you have any concerns, please raise these before you arrive or speak to your Camp Host on arrival.
