ACCOMMODATION

Wainui Heights

Lodge style accommodation, with most rooms having ensuite bathrooms.

East Wing

Large dining, conference and meeting areas, whiteboard, data projector. BYO bedding. Wheelchair access.

46 beds, most rooms with bathrooms

- 1 x twin room
- 8 x twin/quad rooms
- 1 x 12-bed bunk room

West Wing

Small conference room, meeting areas, dining hall, whiteboard, data projector. BYO bedding.

30 beds, most with bathrooms

- 1 x twin room
- 7 x twin/quad rooms

South Wing

This is an overflow area only and cannot be booked independently. BYO bedding.

12 beds, most with bathrooms

- 3 x twin/quad rooms

Powell Village

Great for large groups, with rustic cabins and modern ablution block. Self-clean only.

Includes a dining hall, central green and playing areas. Bunk beds in most cabins - BYO bedding.

Tent Village

Traditional tent camping, our site has a creek running through it and wildlife abounds.

Very basic kitchen block with one commercial oven/cooktop, and a large fridge/freezer and minimal pots and pans. BYO plates, cutlery and other utensils. There are two showers and two toilets. As facilities are minimal, we recommend hiring additional port-a-loos for large groups. Talk to us about options.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Deposits

These are non-refundable 3 months prior to booking date.

Rubbish Collection

Rubbish (not food waste) will be removed by Wainui Park Staff only if recycling rules are followed.

Food Waste

Self-catering groups are responsible for the safe removal of food waste. Food scraps are not to be put into the standard black rubbish bags. We suggest bring your own 'green bin' or buckets for your food waste to take with you for disposal. A fee of \$300 will be charged if this is not followed.

Damages

Please take care as any damage to the buildings will be charged for.

Bedding

Pricing does NOT include bedding, so make sure you are bringing your own pillows and sleeping bags for Powell Village, and a bottom sheet as well if staying in the Heights.

Fires

No fires are to be lit on our property.

Heating

Heaters are not permitted in the Powell Village cabins for fire safety reasons. Warm bedding is recommended. A fire place is located in the Powell Village Dining Hall, fire wood is supplied.

Cleaning

Wainui Heights: Cleaning is completed by Wainui Park staff. Rooms must be vacated by 9am.
Powell Village & Tent Village: Clear written instructions are provided as well as all cleaning products. Wainui Park staff will come and check cleaning to ensure it is to the correct standard before your departure. Fees are payable for cleaning not completed to standard, see your self-clean agreement.

Check Out

Wainui Heights: The check out time on your day of departure is 9am from bedrooms, and 10am from the building. By preorganised arrangement and if availability allows, guests can use the rest of the facility until 2pm, but this may incur a fee of \$75 per hour.

Powell Village and Tent Village: The check out time on your day of departure is 10am. A late fee of \$75 per hour will apply for all late check outs.



ACTIVITIES

You may like to build some activities into your stay. All of our activity sessions are based on one group of up to 12 participants. If your group is larger than 12, you will need to book additional sessions for each activity. Pricing provided on request.

Instructor-Led Activities

Coasteering (3 hours)

Adventure capital! We are going on, around, under and in the coastline with its rocks, seaweed, bird life, sea life, and constantly changing sea.

Giant Swing (90 mins)

This is a huge swing, great for teenagers and adults. A real adrenaline buzz and one of the best views around!

Paddling (3 hours)

Take to the Wainui water using sit on kayaks and stand-up paddle boards for adventure and exploration of the Wainui harbour. Develop team work and paddle skills while playing games and having fun.

High Ropes (90 mins)

This is perfect for groups who want to build up trust, cooperation, confidence and self-awareness.

Archery (90 mins)

You'll get to shoot a bow and arrow at a target and channel your inner hunter as you try to get a bullseye! Your instructor will help teach you how to shoot accurately, as well as setting challenges.

Flying Fox (90 mins)

This is quite a ride, beginning at the top of a small valley and speeding down past the trees.

Instructor-Led OR Self-Led Activities

Orienteering (90 mins)

Use your traditional map reading skills combined with a 'treasure hunt' to find different mapped points around Camp Wainui.

Search and Rescue (90 mins)

Where's Bob? We have lost an instructor; can you work together to locate him? Using clues and Land Search and Rescue skills, teams work together to find Bob who is somewhere around the Camp.

UHF Radios (90 mins)

While learning to use walkie-talkie style radios, the participants explore the camp and play games.

Large Group Activities (no participation limit)

Wide Game or Challenge Event

A structured series of games such as colours or capture the flag.

Camp Fire

Singing, socializing, games and chants are abundant in this much loved Wainui Camp tradition.

Tramp to Camp or Guided Walks

Tramp over the hill from beautiful Tikao Bay to Wainui Camp, or enjoy a tramp to Scenery Nook.
