ACCOMMODATION

Wainui Heights

Lodge style accommodation, with most rooms having ensuite bathrooms.

East Wing

Large dining, conference and meeting areas, whiteboard, data projector. BYO bedding. Wheelchair access.

46 beds, most rooms with bathrooms

- 1 x twin room
- 8 x twin/quad rooms
- 1 x 12-bed bunk room

West Wing

Small conference room, meeting areas, dining hall, whiteboard, data projector. BYO bedding.

30 beds, most with bathrooms

This is an overflow area only and cannot be booked independently. BYO bedding.

12 beds, most with bathrooms

- 3 x twin/quad rooms

Powell Village

Great for large groups, with rustic cabins and modern ablution block. Self-clean only.

Includes a dining hall, central green and playing areas. Bunk beds in most cabins - BYO bedding.

106 beds (up to 116 on request)

Cabins 1-8 and Cabin 11 = 10 beds per cabin

Cabin 9 = 9 beds

Cabin 10 = 7 beds

Tent Village

Traditional tent camping, our site has a creek running through it and wildlife abounds.

Very basic kitchen block with one commercial oven/cooktop, and a large fridge/freezer and minimal pots and pans. BYO plates, cutlery and other utensils. There are two showers and two toilets. As facilities are minimal, we recommend hiring additional port-a-loos for large groups. Talk to us about options.

Catering

Catering is available **September to May** in Wainui Heights and Powell Village
\$48pp per night. Dinner on arrival day. Breakfast and a packed lunch on departure day.

ACTIVITIES

Choose which activity programme best suits your school and budget.

Moa Programme

This programme is instructor-led, which allows you more time to enjoy camp.

- ✓ Six instructor-led 90 min time slots and a wide game included.
- ✓ Choose two of our “big three” activities (coasteering, high ropes, paddling).

Activities are only confirmed once the deposit is paid and dependent on availability. We operate on a first come first served basis.

Huia Programme

This programme is a mix of instructor-led and self-led activities.

- ✓ Three instructor-led 90 min time slots and a wide game included.
- ✓ Three self-led 90 min time slots with your own activities, or use our pre-prepared self-led resource packs.
- ✓ Choose one of our “big three” activities (coasteering, high ropes, paddling).

Activities are only confirmed once the deposit is paid and dependent on availability. We operate on a first come first served basis.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

RUBBISH COLLECTION

Rubbish will be removed by Wainui Park Staff if recycling rules are followed.

FOOD WASTE

Self-catering groups are responsible for the safe removal of all food waste. Food scraps are not to be put into the standard black rubbish bags. We suggest bringing out your own "green bin" or buckets for your food waste to take with you for disposal.

A fee of up to \$300 will be charged to your account in the case of food waste being left on site.

DAMAGES

Please take care as any damage to the buildings will be charged for.

POWELL VILLAGE CLEANING

In Powell Village clear written instructions are provided as well as all cleaning products. Wainui Park staff will come and check cleaning to ensure it is to the correct standard before your departure. Fees are payable for cleaning not completed to standard, see your self-clean agreement.

DEPOSITS

These are non refundable 3 months prior to booking date.

FIRES

No fires are to be lit on our property.

HEATING

Heaters are not permitted in the Powell Village cabins for fire safety reasons. Warm bedding is recommended.

A fire place is located in the Powell Village Dining Hall, fire wood is supplied.

BEDDING

We do NOT supply bedding, so make sure you are bringing your own pillows, sleeping bags and a bottom sheet.

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT

On your day of arrival common areas are available from 12.30pm, and rooms from 2pm. On your day of departure check out time from rooms is 9am, and common areas no later than 12pm (programming can still occur after this time). A late fee of \$75 per hour will apply for all late check outs.
